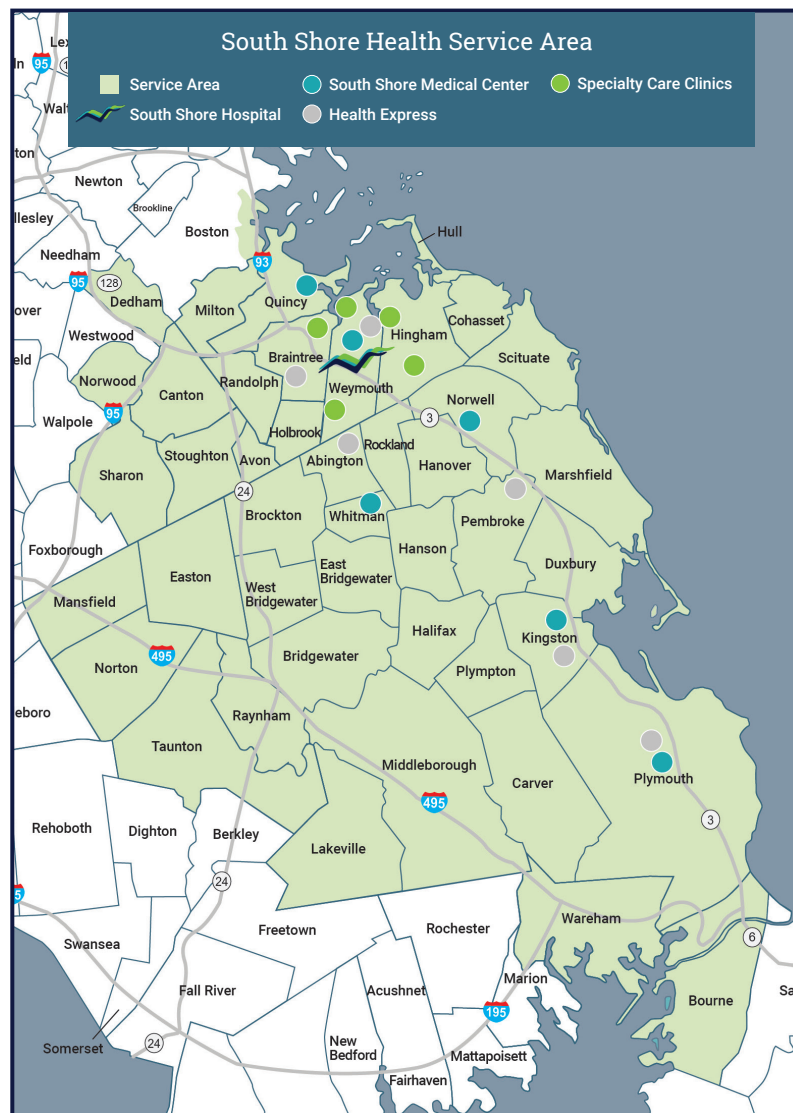

South Shore Health's Breast Care Center, Reproductive Endocrinology, Neurology, Stroke Care, and Surgical Residency Program are all provided in association with physicians from Brigham and Women's Hospital.



Dana-Farber Brigham Cancer Center at South Shore Health provides residents south of Boston with the highest level of advanced expertise in cancer care and support in the region. Experts from Dana-Farber Cancer Institute, Brigham and Women's Hospital, and South Shore Health collaborate to offer many advanced treatments locally, including radiation, chemotherapy, and surgical treatments as well as clinical trials exploring new therapies.



South Shore Hospital's neonatal intensive care, pediatric emergency, and inpatient pediatric services are provided in association with physicians from the world-leading Boston Children's Hospital.



Collaboratively, South Shore Health and Aspire Health Alliance are working together to provide integrated and innovative behavioral health programs for the community.
